APPLICATION PROCESS

OUR HUME TRIPS ARE HANDLED THROUGH AN APPLICATION PROCESS FOR ALL THREE CAMPS — WAGON TRAIN, MEADOW RANCH, AND PONDEROSA. PLACEMENT PRIORITY WILL GO TO THOSE STUDENTS WHO HAVE BEEN ACTIVE.

“Active” means the **STUDENT** has attended our Sunday School and/or Midweek Children’s and Youth programs AT LEAST three times a month since August 2023. This excludes Sunday Worship services, Monday night Bible studies, Children’s/Youth events, and volunteer work. Submitting an application **DOES NOT** guarantee your student a spot. **Please note that we must consider grade and gender ratios when placing students (including from a wait list).**

CANCELATION POLICY

You must inform Quail’s Hume registrar immediately at humeinfo@qlbc.org if you must cancel your camper spot. Cancellations **MUST** be done in writing. **There will be no refunds unless we are able to fill the camper spot.**

1 - CREATE A MAIN GUARDIAN ACCOUNT

STUDENTS CANNOT SIGN THEMSELVES UP

The account **MUST** be CREATED AND MANAGED by a parent or legal guardian.

DO NOT SIGN UP ANY STUDENT OTHER THAN YOUR OWN

Any added participant must be enrolled by their parent/legal guardian. DO NOT sign up cousins/friends.

2 - ADD PARTICIPANTS

THE "ABOUT YOU" SECTION IS RESERVED FOR PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN INFORMATION

As stated before, parents/legal guardians **MUST** be the operator of their CampDoc account. This opening page will request information, phone number, address, etc.

ONCE YOUR "ABOUT YOU" SECTION IS COMPLETE, YOU CAN NOW ADD A PARTICIPANT

A "Participant" stands for "student". Here, you can add your student's information and register/apply for upcoming events.

REFER TO YOUR NOTES

THE FOLLOWING PAGE HAS STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS ON CREATING AN ACCOUNT AND ADDING PARTICIPANTS (STUDENTS) TO YOUR ACCOUNT. IT ALSO HAS INSTRUCTIONS ON APPLYING FOR AN EVENT/CAMP.

1. Create an account - This is to be the parent/guardian's. DO NOT sign up under a student's email or allow a student to sign up themselves.
2. Start by entering in parent/guardian email.
3. You will be sent a "sign up" email; check the inbox of the email you entered.
4. The email you'll receive has a verification link, once you click it, you verify your email. You'll then be sent back to the Camp Doc home page.
5. From there, you'll see your entered email as well as two empty bars; one is for a new password and the other is for confirming the password. **take this time to write this password down somewhere! :)*
6. Once entered, you'll be sent to the "New Participants" page. Participants are students. For each child you will be entering, each will need a participant form filled. Only enter **YOUR** legal children. **DO NOT** enter in friends or any other student other than your own. These are legal forms and this information should **ONLY** be submitted by the parent/guardian. Again, **DO NOT** let students enter in themselves.
7. After you've entered in your first participant's information, you'll be sent to the "About You" page This is where you enter **YOUR** information. This is for the parent/guardian to put in their phone number, email, address. You can also check whether you'd like to receive text message alerts by checking yes/no.
8. Once you've confirmed this information, it'll take you to the participant (student)'s registration page. Here, you will see what this student is registered in. As of now, the student shouldn't have anything listed. To get a student applied or registered for events, select the button labeled, "register for a new session" in the bottom right corner.
9. From here, you'll be sent to the "Select Session" page. This will list all Quail Lakes Baptist Church's available registries and applications. For Hume, each camp, Wagon Train (3rd-5th), Meadow Ranch (6th-8th), Ponderosa (9th-12th), will have their own applications. So for each student you apply for, please make sure the student and event you're applying for are correct.
10. Once an event is selected, a highlighted notice with the selected event will appear. Double check before continuing on.
11. After selecting the correct event, you'll be directed to a "Protection Plan" page. This is a coverage plan offered by Camp Doc and is handled through Camp Doc. Quail **DOES NOT** suggest or dismiss this option/offer. And this is solely up to the parent/guardian.
12. After, you will proceed to the "Confirmation/Transactions" page. There, you will see the cost (if there is any required) listed there. This page is mostly a receipt and does not offer an option to pay. Continue on by clicking, "register" at the bottom.
13. A pop up bubble will come up and notify you that you're successfully registered. From there you can add another registration or close.
14. After you close, this leads you to the application page. This page has the date of when this application is due to be completed. Also on this page, along the side are red dotted topics. Ex. General Info, Allergies.. All of these will need to be filled out. As you complete these, the completed dots will turn green. These all **MUST** be completed for each student. And **MUST** be completed by a parent/guardian.
15. At this point, you can review a student's registrations/applications through the left panel. There, you'll see your student's name and on the direct button under their name will be a registration button. Click it, and you will be able to review all that the student is currently applied/registered in.
16. Selecting any event will take you to a short bio; containing the event contact. And in the bottom right corner is a cancellation request button.
17. To access health form pages and to possibly continue filling out that info; on the left side column, select "Application". There, you will find the page featuring the dotted topics and can continue making changes.

REFER TO THE DATES

PLEASE STAY ON TOP OF THESE DATES

These dates are time sensitive, so whether it's sending in an application, turning in a payment, or completing health forms, these all must be completed according to their dates.

Camp placements, SSO acceptances, any Hume updates, and payment reminders, will be sent via email. **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK YOUR EMAIL REGULARLY.**

STUDENT SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

QUAIL LAKE BAPTIST CHURCH
STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

1 - WHAT IS SSO?

THE QUAIL SCHOLARSHIP IS OUR WAY OF HELPING OUR REGULAR ATTENDEES WHO COULD NOT OTHERWISE AFFORD CAMP. WE HOPE TO HELP THOSE FAMILIES BY LESSENING THE COST OF CAMP.

And with our added Student Service Opportunities (S.S.O.) program, there are even more opportunities to earn funds! Our S.S.O. program is a tiered system set up to help students earn funds for camp through approved service opportunities and biblical studies. Money for Quail Scholarships comes through people who make special donations to our Hume Lake Scholarship account. Some money is donated directly by Quail Lakes Baptist Church families who would like to see students attend camp who otherwise might not be able to due to financial responsibilities. The amount available for financial assistance is limited and dependent on donations and fundraisers.

2 - HOW DOES MY STUDENT QUALIFY?

THERE ARE A FEW IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW REGARDING QUAIL SCHOLARSHIPS AND S.S.O.:

1. Quail Scholarships are available **only to students who are ACTIVE at Quail.** "Active" means the **STUDENT has attended our Sunday School and/or Midweek Children's and Youth programs AT LEAST three times a month since August 2023. This excludes Sunday Worship services, Monday night Bible studies, Children's/Youth events, and volunteer work. Submitting an application DOES NOT guarantee your student a scholarship.**
2. Students participating in the Quail Scholarship begin at the Base Tier. Those interested in earning more towards their fund can work their way through the Middle Tier and finally on to the Top Tier. The **STUDENT** must complete the requirements for each tier. The total possible award in 2024 is 50% of the overall camper fee (depending on the specific camp fee; does not include bus fee) The amount awarded is dependent on the tier system shown below:
3. Quail Scholarships are non-transferable.
4. The deadline to complete any MIDDLE or TOP TIER scholarship requirements is May 5th.

Top Tier: 50%

Required to receive the TOP amount:

- Complete the MIDDLE requirements
- Complete TEN (10) additional S.S.O. hours
- Recite Romans 5

Middle Tier: 33%

Required to receive the MIDDLE amount:

- Complete the BASE requirements
- Complete FIVE (5) S.S.O. hours
- Recite the books of the Bible

Base Tier: 18%

Required to receive the BASE amount:

- Camper is ACTIVE withing children's/youth group at Quail

** These percentages are written out within your notes. Percentages are based on the selected camp's fee, and this does not include the bus fee.*

3 - HOW DOES MY STUDENT PARTICIPATE?

THOSE WHO APPLIED FOR S.S.O. ON THEIR HUME APPLICATIONS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF WHETHER THEY QUALIFY ON FEB. 16

For those students who received notice that they qualified, they will receive S.S.O. emails. Every month, an updated S.S.O. calendar will be emailed out to the parent/guardian. These S.S.O. calendars will have approved events that students can apply to volunteer for. Some events will be labeled specifically as high school-, middle school-, or elementary-level opportunities. **Please pay attention to the colored dots near each event** — these will determine which ages will be appropriate for each event. **If your student did NOT qualify, they CANNOT work these events.**

At events, students after completing their hours will receive an SSO Opportunity Form. Those operating/overseeing the event will sign off and record the student's hours. **This is MOST important**, as it shows proof of the child's attendance and that they did indeed help. These forms will be turned into the church office. **DO NOT** give them to leaders. **It is the STUDENTS responsibility to turn in these forms to receive credit.** When reciting the Books of the Bible and Romans 5, **students MUST recite these in person to their ministry leaders.** These recitations also **MUST be done on time and in person**, video recordings will NOT be accepted. Hours will be recorded and can be accessed by emailing Madie at madison@qlbc.org.
