Dear Parents and Prospective CIT applicants,

This year the CIT position will look a little different as we strive to better what we do at Quail Lakes Day Camp. Please remember that an application does not guarantee a position. We will be asking applicants to provide a reference in their application. A youth group leader is a great example as is anyone that knows their prior volunteer history. This is a leadership training opportunity. We are looking for students who wish to become staff members in the future. We strive to teach professionalism within a day camp atmosphere.

CITs, like staff, are asked to follow a dress code. They will need to be in a comfortable and modest tee shirt and pants or shorts <u>and</u> athletic shoes. CITs will sometimes be at the swimming pool; we ask that they have a backpack with appropriate (1 piece) bathing suits and towels with them on a daily basis. We also may ask that any body piercing be covered up when at Day Camp, as well as any unnatural makeup removed. Sandals are permitted, but CITs must start their day in athletic shoes for games, etc.

CITs will be with a counselor at all times and will need to understand that the Director of Day Camp is their immediate supervisor. Should there need to be corrective action, a CIT may be asked not to return depending on severity. We simply ask that CITs are there to help, be respectful, and act as an example to the younger campers while having fun. CITs are expected to participate in whatever activity is taking place with their unit.

Lastly, we ask that CITs not use electronics during their shift. If they have a cell phone, it will need to be kept in their backpack until Day Camp is over.
